 - VET teacher
 - WBL professional in a company, responsible for young people (e.g. in dual system)
 - WBL professional in a company, responsible for all staff members, acting as a coach for lifelong learning during the professional career (e.g. acting as a guidance counsellor for career development in a company; planning in-house WBL activities such as training courses for special machines, etc.)
- 3) We should have a methodology to avoid overlapping among the partners during the research phase. With view to the wbl-toolkit.eu project of the German NA we should also avoid any overlapping with these 70 tools/materials:
